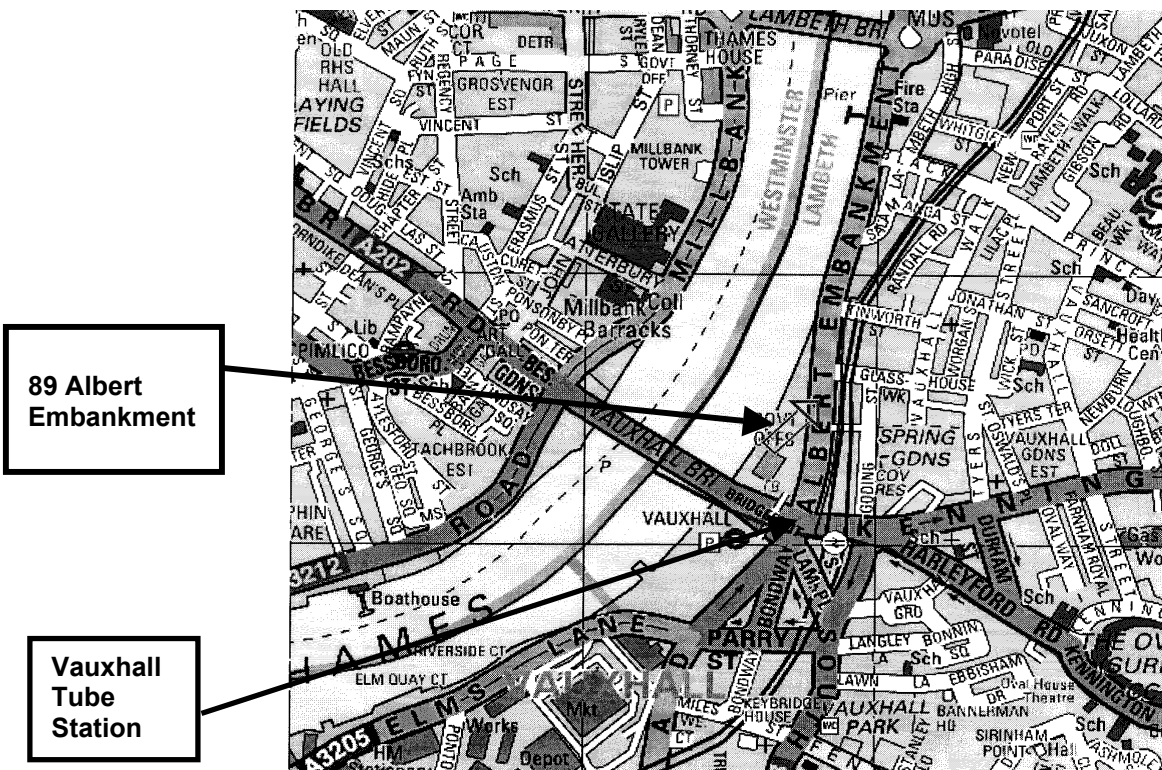

Directions to Vauxhall Tube Station from Mainline stations and Heathrow

- Euston** take the Victoria line southbound six stops to Vauxhall
- Kings Cross/
St Pancras** take the Victoria line southbound seven stops to Vauxhall
- Paddington** take the Circle Line to Victoria and then Victoria Line southbound two stops to Vauxhall
- Waterloo** take a South West Train back one stop to Vauxhall Station (follow directions below). Or catch a 77 bus from outside of the station; get off at the stop opposite 89 Albert Embankment and the M16 building. Alternatively, 89 Albert Embankment is a 10-15 minute walk along the river.
- Heathrow** Heathrow Express to Paddington (follow directions above) or take Piccadilly Line to Green Park and then the Victoria Line southbound three stops to Vauxhall

From Vauxhall Tube Station

We are 5 minutes walk from Vauxhall Station. Take Exit 1 to Albert Embankment. At the crossing, cross over Vauxhall Bridge road and walk past the M16 building (big glass fronted building on your left) and number 89 Albert Embankment is the next building along. Upon arrival at number "Eighty9", please take the lift to the third floor and follow the sign to "Centre for Economic & Social Inclusion".

The office is in a large block served by a lift and is wheelchair accessible. However, not all of the exits at Vauxhall station have ramps.

89 Albert Embankment does NOT have car-parking facilities. There is a public car park in Glasshouse Street – charges apply. There is also parking available a few minutes away in Tinworth Street and is subject to availability. Fees are: £5 for 2-6 hours or £7 per day. Spaces are limited and cannot be reserved.

Please note *Inclusion* is within the congestion charge zone. You can pay the congestion charge either in advance or on the day of travel, before, during or after your journey. The charge is £8 if you pay by 10.00pm on the day of travel or £10 if you pay between 10.00pm until midnight on the day of travel.
